

**Single Disbursement of a one term loan for study abroad students
QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

ESI-Q1. If the participating institution is the coordinating institution as part of a study abroad consortium, and therefore has data on the students who did not receive the treatment (a one-term loan or early disbursement, or both), but the students were not enrolled at the coordinating institution, may the coordinating institution provide data on those students?

ESI-A1. Yes. An institution may send any information that it has on students that participate in a study abroad program coordinated by an institution that is participating in the experiment(s), but it is not required to do so. If the institution chooses to send such data, the information should be sent separate from the information on the students enrolled at the coordinating institutions.

Please note that students who participate in a study abroad program through a coordinating institution, but who remain enrolled at their home institution, may not receive the treatment. [Guidance issued 4/9/2012]
